Activity Two


Tallest to Smallest

Problem Solving

Answer the following problem solving questions.

SKYWALK on the Sydney Tower Eye is 268 metres high. SKYWALK is double the height of the Sydney Harbour Bridge. How tall is the Sydney Harbour Bridge?
There are 1,504 steps that go from Pitt Street Mall to the Observation Deck. If you can run up 100 stairs in 30 seconds, at what speed could you run to the top? Speed = distance/time
There are 1,504 steps that go from Pitt Street Mall to the Observation Deck. If the record for running up the stairs is 6.08 minutes, how many stairs did the record holder climb per second?
Distance = speed x time
There is a 162,000 litre water tank at the top of the Sydney Tower which acts as a stabiliser for the tower. If 10% of the water was removed, how much water would be left?




